It is well recognised that deer don't like the smell of sheep – something to do with competing for grazing perhaps?! Although unproven, there seems to be quite a lot of circumstantial evidence, in which case they're not going to like the new BioWool™ mulch material, which is exclusively available from us.

Available in mulch mats or mulch rolls, our new British manufactured mulch is made from a mixture of unrefined ('raw') and recycled wool, which retains much of the Lanolin content. This ensures that the fibres not only last longer in the natural environment, but also retain their aroma.

One of the problems with using natural fibres as weed suppressant matting is that birds love using them as nesting material. In order to prevent this, our exclusive BioWool™ mulch is woven onto a strong and certified soil biodegradable backing material, which is fully compliant with ASTM D5988/ISO 17556, and which ensures 2-3 years of effective use in the field, before degrading harmlessly into the soil.

The matting is secured to the ground using our special barbed design of 150mm long bamboo pegs which prevents it from pulling through the matting. The new BioWool™ mulch provides a natural, fully biodegradable solution to chemical-free weed suppression – and importantly falls well within the standard costs for EWCO funding.

As with many products, successful application relies both on the suitability of the materials used, and also on the site preparation. Ideally, when laying mulch, any long ground vegetation should be removed in advance by strimming, mowing or screefing, in order that the BioWool™ mulch can be secured 'tightly' to the ground, preventing light ingress and rodents from getting underneath the mulch and undoing all the hard work.
